During **Sharad Ritu (autumn season)**, the **Pitta Dosha** tends to increase, leading to ailments like acidity, arthritis, lethargy, and mental stress. To counter these effects, the camp focused on **Virechana Karma**, a cleansing therapy that helps remove toxins and purify the body.

The project, **funded by RGUHS, Bengaluru**, is titled "Preparation, Standardization & Crop Yield Efficacy of Modified Vegetarian Kunapajala on Godhuma (Triticum aestivum Linn.) – An Experimental Study."

The inauguration was done by **Principal Dr. Mahantesh M. Salimath**, in the presence of college faculties and staff members. The research is led by **Dr. Gangadhar T. Aralelimath** (Principal Investigator) and **Dr. Ashwini Hiremath** (Co-Principal Investigator).

As part of the study, wheat cultivation has been initiated at the SJG Herbal Garden, where the crop is divided into six groups with four replicas for scientific comparison and analysis.

This project aims to explore the effectiveness of the **Modified Vegetarian Kunapajala**, a traditional organic fertilizer, on the **growth and yield of wheat crops**, contributing to sustainable agricultural research through Ayurvedic principles.
























Alzheimer's day competition of final year BAMS Batch
